

NEW YORK BEAUTY - NEEDS LIST.

Fabrics -

This lovely block looks great whatever fabric palette you choose - black and white, batiks, country, vintage, - the list goes on! The most important choice is the fabrics for the background and points of the arc. There should be strong contrast between the two, with the dark having a self pattern. Your large patterned medium fabrics are ideal for the other two sections of the block. This is a great way to use your stash of fat quarters - the orange and green sample quilt took 16 fat qtrs and approx 1.6m of dark brown for the sashings and borders. Raid your scrap bags!

If you wish to pre-cut:-

1. The arc background - cut into 2½in strips.
2. The arc points - cut into 2in strips.

Bring to class.

0.5m of freezer paper

Small ruler/pencils

Square ruler (if you have one)

Sewing machine, cleaned and oiled (if appropriate)

1/4in foot

Fabric scissors (sharp points)

Paper scissors

Rotary cutter and cutting board

Co-ordinating thread

Seam ripper!!
